



The Alberta Professional Chuckwagon and Chariot Association is very excited to, once again, be entertaining the racing fans here in Bruderheim. They are in their 50th racing season and consist of members ranging from 14 years old to 88 years young. They represent the provinces of BC, AB, SK, and MB and have both male as well as female competitors.

This weekend they have competitors from as far away as Moose Jaw, Saskatchewan and locals from as close as Lamont and Fort Saskatchewan. There will be 30 chuckwagons and 33 chariots competing here this year meaning that the APCCA has brought nearly 200 horse to town.

The association is continuing to grow and adds new members and shows annually. The APCCA is also very excited to boast that they have 3 race meets that are **broadcasted live on radio by Country 106.5** from Vegreville. Bruderheim is one of those race meets that is being broadcast so listen in during the races or tune in afterwards to get updated results, standings and interviews.

Bruderheim marks the 10th stop on the APCCA tour which began on May 27th in Alder Flats, AB and will end on September 10 in Millarville, AB. Over those 107 days the APCCA performs for a total attendance of just over 65,000 people and appreciates every one of you.
